


INTERCITY PASSENGER RAIL NETWORK

December 31, 1970





What kind of service should be operated between Boise and Portland? Amtrak currently operates service between Spokane and Portland. Spokane and Boise are of similar size and similar distance from Portland, though few geographic barriers exist on the current Amtrak route. The current westward Amtrak train departs Spokane at 245 AM arriving at Portland at 1010 AM; the current eastward Amtrak train departs Portland at 445 PM arriving in Spokane just after midnight. This allows day trips to and from Portland, in spite of the middle-of-the-night westward Spokane departure. As a result, of the 45 other stations along Amtrak's Empire Builder route through Spokane, the primary travel destination is Portland, Oregon! Portland is also the number 1 destination for travel out of the Tri-Cities (Pasco).






